Date: February 12th, 2023 Text: Revelation 4:5-11

<u>Passage Summary</u>: While the days are dark and there is much that is yet to be fulfilled concerning God's eternal plan of salvation, He opens a <u>door</u> of hope for those who are willing to see!

180 Degree Truth #1: See that the door of hope God opens to all who are willing to see takes the form of a <u>throne</u> room vision of Him in the fullness of His <u>glory</u>! (4:1-11)
