"It was about this time that King Herod arrested some who belonged to the church, intending to persecute them. He had James, the brother of John, put to death with the sword." Acts 12:1-2
180 Degree Truth #1: See that when the reality of sin, evil and suffering hit close to home, more than ever we need to hit our with a steadfast commitment to ! (12:1-10)
"So Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God for him." Acts 12:5
Application: Recognize that when it comes to a steadfast commitment to prayer
