

## How Deep the Father's Love for Us!

Date: March 10th, 2024 Text: John 1:14-18 Passage Summary: As we survey the purpose of the writing of John's gospel, it becomes evident from the outset that he wants his readers to understand that is so much than we often understand Him to be! **180 Degree Truth #1:** See that John's aim for his readers to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God (20:31) begins with an understanding of the Preincarnate \_\_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_\_! (1:14-18) **Application:** Recognize that when it comes to the pre-incarnate Deity of Christ, it is essential to understand that... Jesus is the \_\_\_\_\_\_ for our \_\_\_\_\_! (v.14-18) **Propitiation**: from the Greek word hilasmos, meaning to appease or satisfy; applied to our salvation, it speaks of the manner in which Christ's sacrifice on the cross satisfied the wrath of God for the sin of humanity. See the unique qualities that allow Jesus to be the propitiation for our sins... He had to completely \_\_\_\_\_ with those He came to save: Jesus had to became a \_\_\_\_\_! (v.14-15) "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth." John 1:14 He had to completely \_\_\_\_\_ all of the righteous requirements of God's Law: Jesus had to be \_\_\_\_\_\_ ! (v.16-18) "For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ."

John 1:17

He had to completely absorb the	of God for the sin of
humanity: Jesus had to	the penalty of our sin! (v.16-18)

Remember: When it comes to the pre-incarnate Deity of Christ, no ordinary man on his bravest day, even if he mustered the courage to die the death Jesus died on the cross, would not and could not be a propitiation for our sin; but what man could never do, God did on our behalf through the simple, yet profound theology of John 1:14: "The \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ became \_\_\_\_\_\_ and made His dwelling among us." (John 1:14)
