(1:43) **Application:** Recognize that when it comes to the manner in which Jesus calls disciples, it involves... An unapologetic : Me! (v.43) "The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. 'Come, follow me,' Jesus said, 'and I will make you fishers of men.' At once they left their nets and followed him."
