Text: John 10:11-21

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."

John 10:10

Passage Summary: As the life and ministry of Jesus continues to unfold in John's gospel, Jesus will now turn to the imagery of a shepherd to provide another layer of insight into His Divine character and the profound nature of the salvation He came to offer!

180 Degree Truth #1: See that in contrast to all those who have gone before Him, Jesus truly is the Good Shepherd! (10:11-21)

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep."

John 10:11

_____ the sheep _____! (v.14-15)

"I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me-."

John 10:14

_____ the sheep _____! (v.16)

"I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd."

John 10:16

_____ for the sheep _____! (v.17-18)

"The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life—only to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father."

John 10:17-18
